- ✘ The teachings and values of Jesus Christ are lived out through the Pillars of the Charism of St Marcellin Champagnat SM:

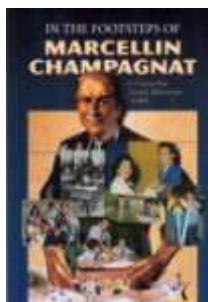

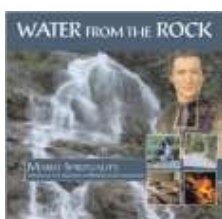
