These priorities and suggestions will form part of the discernment and discussion in preparation for the General Chapter which will be held in September 2025.

Seven priorities were identified. Accompanying each of these was a description of the priority and a number of guidelines.

- Quality Marist Evangelizing Education that shapes the world and is transformative.
- Promotion and Protection of Children and Youth Rights.
- Marist Spirituality as a source of meaning and care for life.
- Participation and engagement of children, adolescents, and youth through spaces of active and sensitive listening.
- [®] Care of Family Relationships to nurture children and youth.
- Care of our common home.
- Promotion of mental health, well-being, and comprehensive care of people.
